AP Courses offered include; Chemistry, Biology, Physics 1, Environmental Science, Calculus AB, English Literature, English Language, World History, US History, Government, & Spanish. All AP courses are open enrollment, although teacher interview is recommended.

Honors courses are offered in English and Science to 9th and 10th grade students that are invited by staff or students that choose to engage in the curriculum.

Frontier Academy is located in Greeley, CO. According to statistics at quickfacts.census.gov, Greeley is an agricultural community of roughly 95,000 people. There are also some more recent technology and retail industry coming to Greeley. The average household income is approximately \$43,000, and individual average income is \$21,000. Approximately 60% of the citizens are white and 35% are Hispanic. 82% of the population over the age of 25 has a high school diploma or equivalency and 26% of the population age 25 or over has a bachelor's degree. The percentage of people living at or below poverty level is 22%.

Frontier Academy offers students many extracurricular activities including; National Honor Society, Key Club, LULAC, Student Council, Robotics club, Academic Decathlon, Knowledge Bowl, Culture Club, and a Charter Theatre Club. Frontier also offers students the following varsity sports; Boys and Girls Soccer, Basketball, Cross Country, Track and Field, and Girls Volleyball. Athletes are also encouraged to participate in sports not mentioned above at other district schools.
