Frontier Graduation Requirements

- We require 28 credits - 1 semester class = .5 credits
- 4 English, 4 Math, 4 Science
- 3 Social Studies
- 2 Technology, 2 PVA, & 2 Foreign Language
- 1.5 Physical Education
- .5 Health
- 5 Elective Credits
- These requirements exceed the Colorado Council of Higher Education Admission Requirements (HEAR).
- Guaranteed NCAA Clearinghouse eligible, pending academics
